

Instructions for joining Alpha Phi Sigma – Theta Xi

Qualifications to be eligible for membership:

- Must be a criminal justice or police studies major or minor
- Must have already completed three full-time semesters (or equivalent)
- Must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.2 (this average must include at least four CRJ or PLS courses)

Please note that these qualifications are mandated by our national office of Alpha Phi Sigma, and must be met before membership into any local chapter can be granted.

Print out two copies of the membership application, using Adobe Reader, and return both original copies. Only applications that are filled out properly will be accepted—all others will be returned for corrections.

In addition, please print out two copies of your DegreeWorks report, and submit along with your two original applications for membership.

On the areas of the application that ask about your GPA information, please leave that blank--Mr. Kappeler can obtain that information from your DegreeWorks information, that you will turn in along with your applications.

Please return **two original applications** and **two copies of your DegreeWorks**, along with a money order (**no checks accepted**) in the amount of **\$50.00**, made payable to Alpha Phi Sigma Headquarters **AND** a money order (**no checks accepted**) in the amount of **\$20.00** payable to **Alpha Phi Sigma – Regional Campuses**. The \$50.00 is for your national membership, and the \$20.00 is for your local chapter dues. Please return the above-listed items to the address, below:
